

# Spring DE Deadline & Reminders

Dear Students and Parents,

As we prepare for the upcoming Spring semester, it is important for qualifying junior and senior students planning to take dual enrollment classes to have all the necessary information to navigate their dual enrollment journey smoothly. Important instructions and reminders have been outlined below to assist students with completing applications and managing required paperwork.

Please pay close attention to the procedures for submitting transcripts, filling out intent forms, and requesting consortium agreements, as these steps are essential for enrollment at Volunteer State (VS) and Tennessee Tech University (TTU).

These highlights represent key instructions, but full details can be found in the TTU handbook and/or the Vol State Checklist.

#### **Important Dates:**

- The deadline for all Spring DE paperwork is January 10th.
- No changes will be made to DE schedules after Winter break.
- If a student is switching DE schools for the spring semester, please remember to update the Dual Enrollment Grant.



Parents and Guardians,

Cookeville High School is enforcing the Putnam County School Board policy in regards to use of personal communication devices and electronic devices. Students may possess personal communication devices and personal electronic devices so long as such devices are turned off and stored in backpacks, purses or personal carry-alls. During classroom instructional time, all cell phones are to be stored in PCSS-approved classroom pocket chart cell phone holders. Unauthorized us or improper storage of a device will result in confiscation until such time as it may be released to the student and/or the student's parents or guardian. A student in violation of this policy is subject to disciplinary action.

# CELL PHONE/ELECTRONIC DEVICE VIOLATION DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

- Warning  - The teacher takes the phone to administration and the offense is documented in PowerSchool.  - Student is able to pick the phone back up at the end of the school day.	- The teacher takes the phone to administration and the offense is documented in PowerSchool.  - The student is assigned to either I day of after-school detention or 2 days of lunch detention.  - Phone is held and given back at the end of the one (1) day of afterschool detention OR phone is held for the day and given back after each of the 2 days of lunch detention.	- The teacher takes the phone to administration and the offense is documented in PowerSchool.  - Student serves 1 day of ISS. The parent is required to pick up the phone after the student has served the day of ISS.	- The teacher takes the phone to administration and the offense is documented in PowerSchool.  - Student serves 3 days of ISS. The phone is given back after each day of ISS served.  - For the remainder of the year after the 4th offense, the student checks in the phone at the office at or before 8 am every school day, and the phone is returned to the student at 3 pm at the end of every school day.

The PowerSchool Parent Portal is an easy-to-use web-based tool for parents and guardians that provides secure, near real time information about your child's grades, attendance, class schedule, demographic information, and more.

#### **How to Create an Account**

The first time, you must create an account using the school's assigned Access ID and Password from a letter sent home at the beginning of school. Your school can also help you with this information.

Things you will need to create your account:

- District Code BQHG is the 4-digit code for Putnam County School System
- The secure access ID Access this ID comes in a letter from their school within the first nine weeks or parents/caregivers can contact the school.

Get started by clicking the log-in page. \*Tutorial videos are also available on the log-in page.

# **PowerSchool Mobile App**

- 1. Install App (Apple or Android)
- 2. Enter District Code BQHG is the 4-digit code for Putnam County School System3. Login using the Student or Parent username and password.

## **Troubleshooting:**

Having issues logging in? It may be that your email is already tied to a PowerSchool account.

Please contact your school to have your password reset.

Mobile App: If parents/caregivers are having issues with the mobile app (seeing last year's info, etc.), they need to delete the app and reinstall it. The old app is being directed to the old URL so a reinstall should fix the problem.
